

Our graduates

The Sunshine Coast Private Hospital (TSCPH) graduate programs are designed to assist nursing graduates (Registered Nurses, Midwives & Enrolled Nurses) as they move from study into the nursing and midwifery workforce.

Programs are designed to provide graduates with a supportive learning environment with structured opportunities for professional development that will ensure they achieve their full potential as Registered Nurses, Midwives & Enrolled Nurses.

About us

The Sunshine Coast Private Hospital, is one of the largest private hospitals outside of the Brisbane metropolitan area. It is part of Uniting Care Health which is the largest not for profit health care group in QLD. As part of UnitingCare there is the opportunity for excellent salary options and employee benefits, including wider educational experiences and career opportunities.

The 190 bed hospital provides a broad range of medical and surgical services including a cardiac catheter laboratory, maternity and mental health. TSCPH is well respected throughout the Sunshine Coast community and is known for attracting and retaining highly qualified and caring staff.





Our program

The graduate nurse program is a part-time (32 hours per week), 11 month program, consisting of two rotations and includes:

- + Placement a variety of clinical specialties;
- + Structured graduate nurse study days;
- + Regular facilitated debriefing meetings;
- + Preceptorship support; and
- + Additional education opportunities across all specialties.

There are three different program opportunities at TSCPH – clinical, perioperative and maternity/nursing.

Clinical Stream

This allows new graduates to experience wide spectrum of experiences in adult nursing practice. The available rotations may include:

- + General surgical, ENT, gynaecology, plastics
- + Orthopaedics, urology, vascular
- + Rehabilitation
- + General medical
- + Mental health
- + Critical care services

Please note: all areas may not be available for every intake of graduates or for every rotation.

If you are successful in obtaining a position on a rotational graduate program at TSCPH, we will provide you with a list of available options.

Peri-operative Stream

There are two Perioperative Programs available at the Sunshine Coast Private Hospital

- 1. Scout Program
- Post Anaesthetic Care Unit (PACU) / Anaesthetics Program

Both programs include a comprehensive theoretical component as well as a supportive clinical component.

Maternity/nursing Stream

This program allows midwives to work across all areas of midwifery, including birth suite, antenatal and postnatal and special care nursery as well as including a general medical or surgical rotation.
